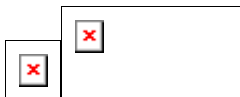

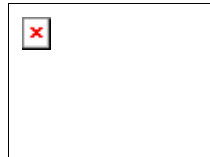
4th Annual Frozen Creek Tourney Seeking Teams



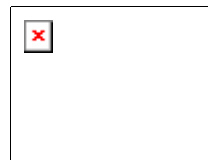
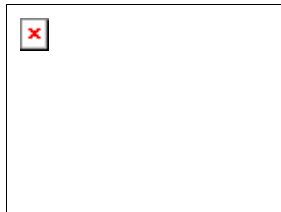

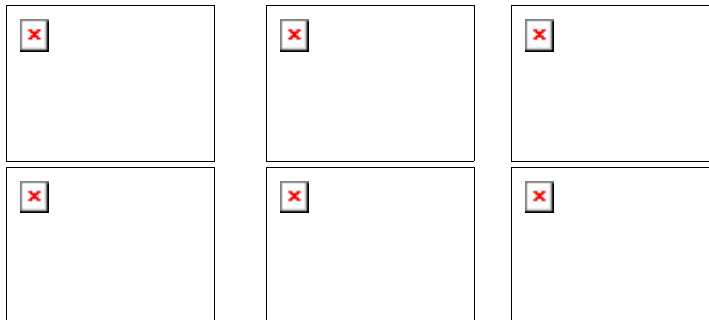

"Honorable Mention" went to Matt Parker, Matt Meier, Mike Folino, and Rick DeBorde with GPA's of 3.5 to 3.75.

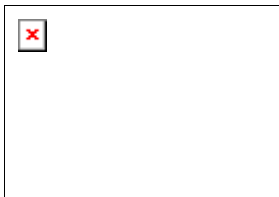

Beavers Trip To State Tourney Short-Lived

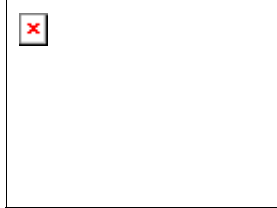
